

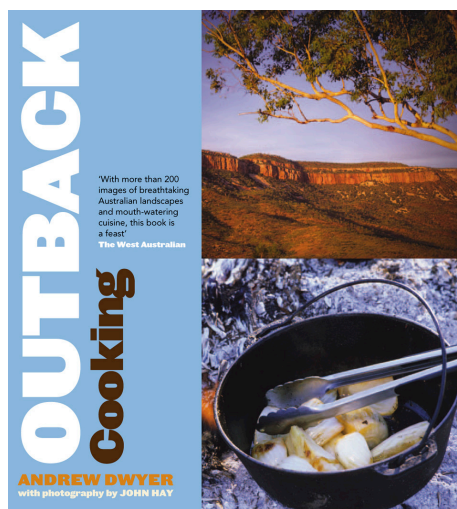

He has worked with food greats such as Stephanie Alexander, Jacques Reymond, Gabriel Gaté and on the award-winning *Cook with Kate McGhie*. He currently lectures on photography at RMIT.
