

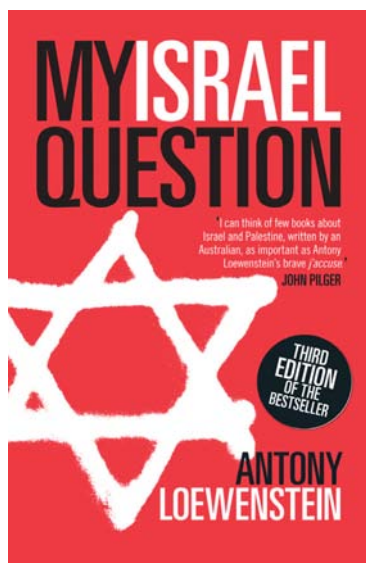

Loewenstein's forensic discussion of the Israeli–Palestinian conflict continues here in a fully updated and expanded new edition, examining the prospects of the Middle East peace process in the new geo-political context.
