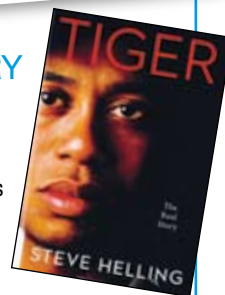

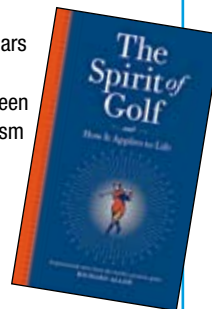
GOLF SENSE
