UFO (October, Hardie Grant) showcases the collected work of Albert Watson, a world-renowned fashion and commercial photographer. This hardcover title covers Watson's 40-year career, including work displayed at the National Portrait Gallery in London and the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York.
